Smith next will start on Wednesday at home against West Michigan.</p> <p><b>GIRON HEATS UP:</b> Shortstop <b>Ruddy Giron</b> hit safely Thursday for a fifth game in a row. Giron has now reached base in 14 consecutive games. Along the way, he's raised his batting average 23 points and his on-base percentage 26 points.</p> <p><b>MILB PLAY OF THE WEEK:</b> Catcher <b>Austin Allen</b>'s window-shattering home run at West Michigan on July 11 was voted Minor League Baseball's Play of the Week by fans this week. Allen's homer was 1 of 6 plays nominated. He took a whopping 93% of the vote.</p> <p><b>GREENE JR. IS MONEY:</b> Catcher <b>Marcus Greene Jr.</b> went 3-for-3, plus a walk, on Thursday. He finished just a triple shy of the cycle.</p> <p><b>LOOONG GAMES:</b> The TinCaps have played 5 consecutive games that have gone at least 3 hours and 7 minutes. Fort Wayne's last 9 games have averaged 3 hours and 21 minutes. Last night's 3 hour, 42-minute game was the team's longest 9-inning game this season.</p> <p><b>BIG BRAD BASHES:</b> First baseman <b>Brad Zunica</b> is tied for the Midwest League lead in home runs with 13. The 20-year-old has averaged a homer once every 21.77 at-bats this season, although that ratio is even higher in the second half, in which he's launched 7 long balls. (Fort Wayne's franchise home run record is 20 — set by Jake Patterson in 1997.)</p> <p><b>BURT HOOTON BOBBLEHEAD:</b> The TinCaps will be giving away free Burt Hooton bobbleheads, sponsored by Source One Solutions, at Parkview Field before their game on Sunday, Aug. 21. Hooton, Fort Wayne's 66-year-old pitching coach who pitched for 15 years in the majors, has been with the TinCaps for four seasons now.</p> <p><b>INDIANA BICENTENIAL JERSEYS:</b> A week from tonight, on Friday, July 29, the TinCaps will celebrate Indiana's 200th birthday with a special theme night at Parkview Field. The team will wear special jerseys in the likeness of Indiana's state flag. Fans can bid on those now at TinCapsJersey.com. Proceeds benefit Fort Wayne Trails.</p> <p><b>BACK AT PARKVIEW FIELD:</b> The home of the TinCaps is in preparation to host concerts the next two days. ### COACHING STAFF

**Anthony Contreras (Manager)** is in his first season as Fort Wayne's manager and is the first former Fort Wayne player to return to manage the team. Contreras, 32, comes to Fort Wayne after managing the Padres' Short-Season A affiliate, the Tri-City Dust Devils (Northwest League), in 2015. Contreras led Tri-City to a 42-34 record, a division title, and a run to the Northwest League Finals. Contreras made his professional managerial debut in 2014 with the Rookie-level Peoria Padres (Arizona League). Contreras, who grew up in San José, California, played collegiately for four years at San José State (2002-05). The San Francisco Giants selected Contreras in the ninth round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft. Over nine years in Minor League Baseball that peaked in Triple-A, he sported a .257 batting average. He played in San Diego's organization from June 2008-August 2013. With the Wizards, Contreras had one of the best statistical stretches of his career. In 36 second-half games, he played second base, third, and shortstop, and batted .304. Coincidentally, Contreras concluded his playing career with the Lancaster Barnstormers of the independent Atlantic League in 2013. His hitting coach there was current TinCaps hitting coach Lance Burkhart.

**Burt Hooton (Pitching Coach)** returns to Fort Wayne and the Padres organization for his fourth season. Hooton, who once threw a no-hitter for the Cubs against the Phillies on April 16, 1972, spent 15 years in the majors with the Cubs (1971-75), Los Angeles Dodgers (1975-84), and Texas Rangers (1985). He finished his major league career with a 151-136 record with 1,491 strikeouts more than 2,652 innings pitched. For the World Series champion Dodgers in 1981, Hooton was named an All-Star and MVP of the National League Championship Series. The Greenville, Texas native began his coaching career in the Dodgers organization in 1988 and has made six different coaching stops prior to joining Fort Wayne. Among those stops, Hooton served as the Houston Astros pitching coach from 2000-04.

**Vinny Lopez (Hitting Coach)** is in his first season as Fort Wayne's hitting coach and in his first year in the Padres organization. Lopez spent the past two seasons in the Astros organization as the hitting coach for their Gulf Coast League squad. Prior to joining the Astros, Lopez logged three seasons with the Texas Rangers, first with the Hickory Crawdads of the Class-A South Atlantic League (2011) and then with the Spokane Indians of the Short-Season Northwest League (2012-13). Lopez has also previously served as a coach in the Cape Cod Baseball League with the Orleans Firebirds and with the University of Southern California, where he earned his master's degree in education in 2011 and graduated with honors. Lopez played at California Lutheran University, graduated in 2008 and played professionally in the French Baseball Federation.
